2. Scope of Processed Data

In connection with booking and providing services, the following data may be processed:

- full name
- date of birth
- phone number
- email address
- invoicing details (if required)
- information necessary to perform the treatment

If required for safe provision of services, health-related data may also be processed solely on the basis of consent.

3. Purposes and Legal Bases

Personal data are processed for the purpose of:

- booking and providing services
- contacting clients
- maintaining documentation
- issuing invoices and fulfilling accounting obligations
- establishing or defending legal claims
- informing about own services

Legal bases for processing:

- Article 6(1)(b) GDPR – performance of a contract or pre-contractual actions
- Article 6(1)(c) GDPR – compliance with a legal obligation
- Article 6(1)(f) GDPR – legitimate interests of the Controller
- Article 9(2)(a) GDPR – consent (for health data)

Providing data is voluntary; however, failure to provide required data may prevent the provision of services.

4. Data Recipients

Data may be shared with:

- persons cooperating with the Controller
- accounting and legal advisors
- IT service providers
- marketing and advertising tool providers (including Google and Meta)

Data are shared only to the extent necessary.

Due to the use of external tools, data may be processed outside the European Economic Area in accordance with GDPR requirements.

5. Data Subject Rights

You have the right to:

- access your data
 - rectify inaccurate data
 - request erasure or restriction of processing
 - object to processing for marketing purposes
 - data portability
 - withdraw consent at any time
 - lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority

6. Data Retention

Personal data are stored for the duration of service provision and thereafter for the period required by applicable law, including tax and civil law regulations.

Data processed on the basis of consent are stored until the consent is withdrawn.
